They range from entrance scholarships for exceptional academic results, to supports for sports excellence, or particular subject areas such as music, the arts and many more.

Points Concession / Reduced Points Requirements

- The college adds additional points to your initial CAO points score, based on how you did in the Leaving Cert, to enable you to access a college course.
- Ex: University of Galway offers a limited number of scholarships to athletes who apply for courses that need more than 350 points.
- 40 points are added for successful applicants, who may also be able to access the additional benefits of their Sports Scholarships.
- The college provides points/incentives to encourage students who may not otherwise attend university.

• **Performance Sport Scholarships** - supports athletes who have the talent and dedication to combine an academic course with excellence in sport.

- Among current and past scholars are Olympic medallists, National Champions and Internationals in Rugby, Rowing, Boxing, Swimming, Basketball, Athletics, Windsurfing, Climbing and Sailing amongst others. Our GAA teams can boast of All Ireland Champions in Football, Ladies Football, Camogie and Hurling at senior, u21 and minor levels.
- The Scholarship program has been strategically developed not just to reward their ability and previous performances but to assist these young athletes develop their sporting ability hand in hand with their academic progress by putting in place the necessary supports.

Incoming First Year Applicants

Scholarship applications open for incoming first year CAO applicants in December yearly. **Closing date for incoming CAO applicants is April 1st yearly**. The minimum requirement to apply is to represent your county at U17 grade upwards. The link to the online application form can be accessed from November.

Maynooth University-Sport Scholarships

- GAA Sports awards scholarships to talented individuals in Gaelic games. The scholarships are sponsored by MBNA/Bank of America and the Leinster GAA council. Applicants are required to demonstrate a high level of performance in one of the following sports: hurling, Gaelic football, camogie, or ladies' football.
- Rugby scholarships are awarded to players of outstanding ability. The scholarships work as a
 contract signing the successful scholars to Barnhall RFC firsts as well as a commitment to NUI
 Maynooth for games and training.
- Soccer Scholarships are intended for student athletes with proven or perceived potential to perform at a high level. Application is open to all regardless of which school or club you are currently play for.

- **Golf scholarships** offer a structured golf programme. Applicants should hold a handicap of scratch or better for men and 2 or better for women, and should apply to NUI Maynooth through the CAO.
- NUI Maynooth offers the only **snooker scholarship** in the world. Cofunded by NUI Maynooth Snooker Club and Republic of Ireland Billiards and Snooker Association (RIBSA), it provides successful candidates with

professional coaching and a bursary.



Trinity College Dublin - TCD



Sporting scholarships - A limited number of Sporting Scholarships are offered to full time students who are accepted into Trinity College. Applicants should have outstanding ability in a particular sport, and desire to represent the University in their sport.

There are no points concessions made.

Sports Scholarships

• Trinity Sport offer between 30-40 **high-performance scholarships** each year as well as a number of specific rugby scholarships. There are different tiers of scholarships, ranging in value, worth up to €3,500.

Eligibility:

- Sport scholars should be competing at the highest national level possible in their chosen sport and have been offered a place in the University.

University College Dublin - UCD

- **UCD Sports Scholarships** are awarded to applicants of outstanding sporting ability.
- The aim of the UCD Sports Scholarship programme is to give talented young people the opportunity of developing their sporting career by offering the highest standards in coaching, training, nutrition, strength and conditioning advice, while also completing their chosen course of study.
- The value of each scholarship is assessed on an individual basis and may be used to off-set costs such as accommodation, books, fees and travel to competitions etc.

Sport Scholarships at UL

- Paddy Dooley Rowing Club Scholarships awarded to rowers of exceptional ability €2,500 annually open to undergraduate students from all years. Applications close 1st November each year.
- *Munster GAA Scholarships* Munster Council of GAA and the University of Limerick award 13 new bursaries each year valued at €750, to students from Munster, registered for bachelor degrees at UL.
- The Bank of Ireland GAA High Performance Scholarship The scholarship scheme is open to all current UL Students or those applying to come to UL for the first time either through the CAO or transferring at undergraduate or postgraduate level. Awardees receive financial assistance in the form of a scholarship payment.
- The Michael Hillery and Jacinta O'Brien Athletics Scholarship This Athletics scholarship, honouring the memory of Michael Hillery and Jacinta O'Brien, deceased members of the UL community is estimated as equivalent in value of €7,000. Range of benefits included.

Silver Sports Scholarships cater for developing athletes, who are aiming to reach the highest level in their chosen sport.

 - Tailteann Cup Football
 - Jack McGrath or Kay Mills Camogie
 - Mary Quinn Memorial or Junior Championship Ladies Football
- Rugby AIL, Former Provincial Development Squad or Underage IRFU International ~ within previous 2 years
- Soccer U19 FAI League of Ireland (Premier/Division 1), Former Underage FAI International ~ within 2 previous years
- Other Sports Former International Athlete (within previous 2 years), Provincial Development Squad, National Level

TUS Limerick Sport Scholarships

TUS Bronze Sports Scholarships:

- Bronze Sports Scholarships are designed to support athletes who compete at club/non-elite level, and also contribute towards their respective sport(s) in other capacities e.g. administration, coaching, fundraising, promotion, etc.
- Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis.

Please Note that: scholarship Applications for 23/24 academic year are now open



TUS Limerick Sport Scholarships

Successful applicants must meet the following criteria:

- The applicant must be a prospective or current TUS student.
- Prospective students must meet their course entry requirements through the CAO system and accept, enrol
 and register in a full-time course in TUS in 2023/2024.
- Current students must have successfully passed their examinations, show satisfactory academic progression and have excelled in their chosen sport.
- Compete at the highest level in your chosen sport while in TUS.
- Show satisfactory attendance at matches, training and classes while playing with TUS.
- Help with coaching, administration, promotion and development of your sports club in TUS.
- Successful applicants may be called for interview. The final decision on each application lies with the TUS Sports Council. TUS has the right to terminate your scholarship if criteria are not adhered.

Sports Scholarships at MTU

• MTU Cork Campus Sport Scholarships are awarded to full-time registered students who display a high level of achievement, commitment and dedication to their chosen sport. These are awarded across a wide range of sports and a significant number of these are reserved for first year students.

Scholarship Details:

- Past recipients were involved in Athletics, Basketball, Boxing, Camogie, Football, Handball, Hockey, Hurling, Judo, Ladies Soccer, Rowing, Rugby, Soccer and Tae Kwon-Do
- Value: Up to a maximum of €1,000 per year, subject to satisfactory academic performance each year
- **Duration:** For the full course i.e. of 2, 3 or 4 years duration, subject to annual review
