

Policy on Environmental Education

Environmental Education

Environmental education is a process through which individuals and groups acquire knowledge, understanding and attitudes that will lead to improved behaviour patterns towards their natural and manmade environment.

It is the policy of our school that the environment will be considered in its totality with a view to environmental education becoming a lifelong process. All teachers will by their words and actions endeavour to make their pupils aware of and more caring to their environment.

Environmental awareness will be highlighted in the following classes: Science, Art, CSPE, Technology, History, Geography, Business studies, Green Schools, SPHE etc

Care of the local environment will be emphasised at regular student's assemblies.

- Environmental student ambassadors will be appointed to help people understand and participate in all new initiatives
- A suite of bins will be placed at strategic places around the school to maximise recycling
- There will be strong and productive communication between school personnel and the waste management company with the contract for the removal of waster
